Allergy Alert™ Button (1 Day Pop-up) Forecast

You chose the **Allergy Alert™ Button (1 Day Pop-up) Forecast**



Clicking the Allergy Alert button will open a new window with the one-day allergy forecast for you area. We provide you with a button and code to add to your site.

If this is not the forecast you want, please [click here](#) to select a different forecast.

1. Add Pollen.com Button to your website – this button will be the link to your Allergy Alert page.

Decide where you would like to place the Pollen.com Button on your website. For your convenience we have included the image below. You can copy the image to save on your server or refer to it from our server's address.



To copy button/image for your server -

Right click on the button/image and choose "Save Target As" or "Save Image As". Save to a folder on your computer and upload to your server.

3. Insert the following code into the `<head>` tag of your Allergy Alert page.

Insert the following code into your Allergy Alert page.

*** Must be placed within the <body> tag.**

4. Make sure your Affiliate ID has been properly inserted for you in Display Code 1 & 2. In both instances the code should look like this: "affiliateid=ID#".
5. If you would like to change your zip code to one other than the zip code you signed up with, enter it in all places that reference, "19038"..
6. Verify that your button and Allergy Alert are functioning correctly.

When a visitor enters their zip they will get a pop-up window with a one-day report for the zip entered. We provide you with a zip code entry box and all necessary code.

1. Copy the following lines of text:

2. Paste the text on the line prior to the closing head tag (</head>) in the page of your code.

3. Copy the following lines of text:

4. Paste the lines in the page of your code in the location where you would like the link to be seen by users.

1. Your affiliate ID has been pre-inserted for your convenience. Please check that the number is correct in the three locations marked "affiliate id" in the code below.
2. Enter the zip code for the area to be displayed on your site where the code reads "zip=19038".
3. It is very important that the affiliate ID number and zip code are inserted properly. Please double-check the numbers since the page will not load properly if you have not entered the correct information.
4. Once you have entered your affiliate ID and zip code, copy the following lines of text and paste on the page in your code where you want the allergy alert to be displayed.
